Mike and Thom's expertise coupled with the knowledge of the other experts will focus on male survivors of childhood sexual abuse.

Mike Lew has worked with thousands of men and women in their healing from the effects of childhood sexual abuse, rape, physical violence, emotional abuse and neglect. He conducts public lectures, workshops for survivors, and training and consultations for mental health, medical, clergy, law enforcement and other professionals throughout the United States, in Canada, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, Africa and Asia.

Mike has taught at The City College of New York, Quinnipiac College, The College of New Rochelle and the University of California, Santa Cruz.

Mike is the author of Victims No Longer: The Classic Guide for Men Recovering from Sexual Child Abuse.

"They will be damaged physically, emotionally, mentally and spiritually. Every aspect of their lives will be affected. When they become adults, they will be plagued with sexual dysfunction, troubled relationships, a poor sense of self-worth and intimacy difficulties. Many will become drug addicts. Some will destroy themselves.

Most of them will suffer the effects of sexual abuse without ever realizing that they were victimized. When they read or hear about sexual abuse they probably will not hear about male victims"

It is now widely acknowledged that what was thought to be a rare occurrence, in fact affects 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys. On average it takes boys 23 years to disclose childhood sexual abuse and most never do.

You are likely to meet many such clients in the various services you work within, maybe without being aware of what might lie behind the presentations and issues that you see. Our training offers you an opportunity to understand something of the experience of male survivors.

Understanding trauma can help us make sense out of what may seem nonsensical for both staff and clients.
